# Soklofske Cemetery, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

This small plot about forty feet square located on the east side of an upgraded prairie trail one mile north of Burstall, Saskatchewan, was totally forgotten until a few years ago. As at July 1995, a new fence was erected and the grass is kept trimmed. There are eight known burials, with most of the graves being marked.

## St. Michael's Catholic Church, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

Sometime during the late 1960's, several members of this parish purchased a building from the town, it had previously been used by the Baptist congregation. The first Mass was conducted by Father Reschney of Liebenthal, Saskatchewan. Mass was not held on a regular basis. An organizational meeting was held March 25, 1970, and a later meeting established the first church board. In August 1970, Bishop Ami Decosse declared the mission of St. Michael's of Burstall, Saskatchewan, officially established as of May 17, 1970.

Father Reschney was transferred to be replaced by Father Klein who served and conducted regular mass from March 1970 until December 19, 1975. Father Wagner of Richmound, Saskatchewan conducted mass after the sudden passing of Father Klein, Father Wagner was replaced by Father Joe Blatz in August 1976.

The small building soon became too cramped; therefore the parish purchased a building from Peace Lutheran Church at Leader, Saskatchewan. The church was moved to Burstall, Saskatchewan, and was in place by August 1978. The first mass in this building was October 08, 1978. The official opening June 26, 1979, saw BishopNoel Delequis as celebrant, Father Provincial and several priests from neighbouring parishes assisted.

On August 27, 1979, a farewell mass was celebrated for Father Joe Blatz who was replaced by Father Ron Rissling on November 11, 1979.

The first wedding at St. Michael's was celebrated November 1979, when Tammy Kelln and Paul Dietrich were married.

# St. Paul's Lutheran, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

Many of the early settlers in the Burstall, Saskatchewan, area had been baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in their homelands. Some had been involved in establishing congregations in the United States after emigrating from Russia. It was due to their needs to have a common place to worship that with the help of missionaries they established both the Schmidt and St. Paul's congregations.

In 1908 the Canadian District of Ohio Synod was organized at Winnipeg, Manitoba. In 19 I 1, Pastor Theodore Lassen came to the Deer Forks district (before Burstall was in existence) and held services in pioneer homes and later, in 1912 at various rural schools.

In 1914, Reverend Lassen left the area and a short while later, Reverend Busch took over the pastoral duties. He held Sunday services and Sunday School for the children. At about this time, the Schmidt congregation built a church on land donated by August Graff. Mr. Moos donated the land for the cemetery. The church five miles east of Burstall, Saskatchewan, built by Christ Rothfusz with help from many volunteers was completed in 1915. The second congregation had been holding services at Alexander Plains School since 1913. They decided to build a church on land donated by Gottfred Schimpf, a parsonage on land donated by Christ Schuler and the cemetery on land donated by John Stuhlmiller. Jacob Ruff had earlier donated the property for Alexander Plain School. The parsonage was built after 1913 and the cemetery was being used but the church was never built on this site. The two congregations shared their pastors and facilities. Reverend P. Bethmann was pastor from 1918 to 1921. After the village of Burstall, Saskatchewan, was incorporated in 1921, St. Paul's congregation decided to build their church in town. In 1922, they purchased and dismantled a building at Estuary, Saskatchewan, then used the lumber to build their church. The Schmidt congregation bought St. Paul's parsonage and moved it to their location. Reverend Bietsch was pastor of both churches at this time. He was responsible for establishing services and Saturday School conducted in German.

Reverend G. Daechsel served from 1926 to 1929, he was replaced by Reverend D. Waschenfelder who served until 1937, then Reverend G. "Papa" Weiss served until 1942. During this period the "Ladies Aid" was organized. Reverend R. Stelzer from Leader, Saskatchewan, served this congregation as well as Leader and Mendham, Saskatchewan.

The Schmidt church ceased its operation in 1944, the members transferred to st. Paul's. Near this time the congregation took over full responsibility for conducting Sunday school. In 1947, St. Paul's joined the Hilda and Schuler, Alberta, congregations.

Reverend J. Judt came to serve the three congregations who had been without a pastor for five years. English and German services were now alternated. When Reverend Judt left in 1950, the congregation was without a pastor until 1951 when Reverend H. Weber came to serve. Reverend Senft came from Medicine Hat, Alberta, whenever possible.

The congregation wanted to continue alternating German and English services, this resulted in some difficulty in finding a pastor until Reverend Hans Steinert filled the position in 1958.

At this time the church received a face lift, including a doubling in size, a basement and a new organ, all the work was contributed by volunteers. The German services were discontinued during this period. Reverend Steinert served until 1963, he was replaced in August 1964, by Pastor J. Von Schriltz, a United States Seminary graduate.

Reverend Ole Bruun served in the 1970's. In 1979, St. Paul's started sharing its cemetery with St. Michael's Catholic Church. Pastor D. Knutson replaced Pastor Bruun. An office addition was completed in July 1980. St. Paul's celebrated its 70th. anniversary in 1981.

The cemetery is located one mile east of Burstall, Saskatchewan, on highway 321 NE 36-19-29-W4. The records are kept at Trinity Lutheran Church in Leader, Saskatchewan. This is one of the few rural cemeteries still in regular use. As in most cemeteries, many graves are unmarked and exact records are not available. All the Lutheran burials are along the east side while the west side is being used by St. Michael's Catholic Parish from Burstall, Saskatchewan. The two congregations take care to provide the required maintenance. As at July 01, 1996.

Besides the confirmed graves there are 21 unidentified graves in this cemetery, they are marked with a white metal cross. Records at st. Paul's indicate the following could also be interred here.

## Schmidt Lutheran Cemetery, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

The cemetery is located five miles east of Burstall, Saskatchewan, on the north side of highway 321. Legal land description is SE 03-20-28-W3. The records are kept at Trinity Lutheran church Leader, Saskatchewan. The Lutheran church from this site was moved to the Neu Kronsfelt location seven miles west and four miles north of Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan. The two acre plot is enclosed with a barbed wire fence, little attention is given to maintenance. The last interment was in the early 1960's.

# Hope Evangelical Cemetery, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

The prayers of the pioneers for spiritual fulfillment were answered in June 1911, when Reverend John S. Bum and Brother L. Amacher, a pastor from Medicine Hat, Alberta, drove northeast on a missionary tour which extended to Happyland, Saskatchewan. Services were held near Schuler, near the Schmidt Post Office and in the Happyland region. Brother Amacher served the area twice, after which Reverend J.S. Bum continued the ministry, coming to visit once every four or five weeks, and staying for two or more Sundays.

During the winter, Reverend Bum served at Regina, Saskatchewan, returning in June 1912 to continue the work. Services were held in various places in the Happyland district.

In the spring of 1914, six families, with the help of God, built a church on the Schmidt Appointment, at a cost of about \$1800.00. Reverend F.E. Martin was serving the field at this time. He and Mr. Fred Ehnisz did much of the carpentry work on the building. Because of their faith and hope in God, they named this small church, "Hoffnung" or "Hope Church" and on August 30, 1914, it was dedicated by Reverend L. Wagner, Superintendent of Missions.

The charter members were: Mr. and Mrs. Henry Richter, Mr. and Mrs. John Klanger, Mr. and Mrs. Wilhelm Blischke, Mr. and Mrs. Martin Shauer, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Ehnisz and Mr. and Mrs. John Ehnisz.

The first Baptismal service was held December 06, 1914, by Reverend F.E. Martin, when Mr. and Mrs. John Eszlinger and Mr. and Mrs. Henry Becker brought their infants, Ella Eszlinger now Mrs. Ted Jesske and Rheinhold Becker to the alter to be Baptized.

On January 03, 1915, Reverend F. Martin added three new members to the membership roll. They were Mr. and Mrs. Philip Ehnisz and Kathryn Eszlinger. Kathryn, the first bride married in this church became Mrs. Louis Heinrich on February 04, 1917. Reverend Martin also officiated at this wedding.

Three young men answered the call to God, to full time service for Him: G.F. Wuerfel in 1930, T.E. Jesske in 1936 and A.W. Roth in 1951.

The 25th. anniversary of the church was celebrated July 28 to 30, 1939, with Reverend F. Martin (founder) as guest speaker. Reverend H. Riegel was resident pastor at the time.

The congregation decided to move this country church into Burstall, Saskatchewan, October 1964. The objective was to reach more people in town due to its recent expansion. Reverend Brandt was the pastor at this time.

All former members were invited back to help celebrate the 50th. anniversary June 20, 1965. Guest speakers were the Conference Superintendent Reverend Ted. Jesske and Reverend A. Stickel.

The church has been enlarged and completely face lifted, making it look like a recently built church.

This cemetery is located two miles south and three miles east of Burstall, Saskatchewan. Legal land description is SW 28-19-28-W3. Care has been taken to build a good barbed wire fence and the grass was neatly clipped as at September 02, 1996. This is about a four acre plot. First burial was 1916 and the last burial in 1990.

## Burstall Baptist Cemetery, Burstall, Saskatchewan.

The church known as the Liebenthal Baptist Church was built in 1914, as a member of the General

Missionary Society of the German Baptist Churches of North America. This church operated in the country location until 1929 when it was moved to its present location at Burstall, Saskatchewan. At this time, January 11, 1929, it was renamed the Burstall Baptist Church.

The church operated until 1963 when all assets were turned over to the North American Baptist Association at Forest Park, Illinois. The property was managed by the town of Burstall, Saskatchewan, until it was sold to St. Michael's Catholic Church.

The cemetery is located two miles south of Burstall, Saskatchewan. The legal land description is NE 23-19-29-W3M. The plot is in dire need of maintenance. Most of the fence has fallen down, soil drifting from the west had completely covered many graves and markers, this soil had been removed from those graves that have markers. The records for this plot are not available leaving the number of burials unknown. The church was moved into Burstall, Saskatchewan, many years ago and today, September 02, 1996, it serves as a workshop.
