Neu Kronsfield Lutheran Cemetery, Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan.

The Neu Kronsfield Evangelical Lutheran congregation was organized in 1911, this congregation worked together with Good Hope Church, the members never had a pastor who they could call their own. No parsonage was ever built and a pastor never became resident in the congregation. The pastor lived in a parsonage at the Good Hope church site.

Some of the founding families were the August Kindopps, Jacob Herters, and the C. Grishowsbys. The first congregation consisted of about fifteen families.

Mr. Jakob Herter donated two acres of land for the church site and was paid \$25.00 for the third acre. Reverend Shorman was the first Pastor, followed by Reverend Schmidt in 1929 Reverend Manz in the mid 1930's, Reverend Trelle in 1938 and Reverend Jute in 1948.

A meeting held November 27, 1917, indicated that a building be moved onto this site. A large barn was built on the property in 1918. This barn was sold for \$40.00 in 1961 to Henry Elle.

There were the usual trying times during the depression years, but the congregation managed to pay its accounts and maintain a regular Sunday service.

The minutes were recorded in German up to January 07, 1947 at which time Otto Schwab started recording them in English. English hymnbooks were introduced in 1954.

On June 12, 1948, the congregation decided to purchase the Schmidt Church located five miles east of Burstall, Saskatchewan, for \$1000.00. They sold their old building to Jakob Herter for \$275.00. The dedication service September 19, 1948, was conducted by Reverend Trelle and Jute with about two hundred persons attending. Other pastors who served this station were: Webber in 1951, Emil Krause, Behrens from 1960 to 1963, Odeman to April 1967 and Score through May 1967.

By the mid 1960's new problems plagued the congregation, attendance was declining and meetings were not being supported. The last budget set in 1969 called for the expenditure of \$2500.00. The whole parish was no longer able to support one pastor.

A motion to disband was made June 05, 1970. The assets were disposed and the church building was sold to A. Zollner for \$200.00. All that remains is the one acre plot that holds the sleeping pioneers.

This cemetery is located seven miles west and four miles north of Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan. The legal land description is SE 28-15-28- W3. The property is well fenced but overgrown with high grass. There is indication that some recent work has been done on a number of the graves as at August 30, 1996.

There are a number of graves along the west fence that have been covered in blow dirt from an adjoining cultivated field. First burial in 1918 and last burial in 1968. Church records prior to 1936 are missing and feared lost forever. Information was received from Pastor Emil Krause or taken from grave markers and local history books.

Annenthal German Baptist Church, Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan.

The quarter acre plot is fenced with barbed wire on steel posts and the grass was neatly trimmed as at October 11, 1996. The Annenthal church was situated in the same corner of land, with the church being closest to the road, and the cemetery and barn situated farther east, behind the church. The church opened in the early 1900's, after the congregation disbanded, the building was sold to Ray Makus in 1956 for \$600.00. This church shared ministers with the Rosenfeld church, Annenthal had services in the afternoon and Rosenfeld in the morning. The cemetery is located seven miles west and three miles north of Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan, on the NW 15-15-28-W3.

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIG STICK #141

The office for this municipality is located on Railway Street at Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan, their records indicate only two cemeteries in that area, Rosenfeld Baptist Cemetery located on SW 13-15-26-W3, seven miles east and two miles north of town, on the east side of highway #21, and the Golden Prairie Cemetery located in the northeast corner of SE 03-15-27-W3, one half mile north of town, on the west side of the road. Of course we know that many other cemeteries are situated in this municipality, those records follow.

Rosenfeld Baptist Church, Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan. SW 13-15-26-W3.

The church was, and the cemetery is located in the Rural Municipality of Big Stick, seven miles east and two miles north of Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan.

The name Rosenfeld was chosen by a group of immigrants that had relocated here from Drake, North Dakota, they had been members of the Rosenfeld church at that location. The congregation was formed March 05, 1911, with twenty three charter members. Samuel Boettcher, one of the earliest settlers in this area was instrumental in organizing the church. Another early settler, Gottfried Jaster as layman, conducted many of the early services. From 1912 to 1915, church services were held in the Rosenfeld school, with Reverend A. Kujat holding a position of colporter, he visited and encouraged pastorless churches.

The first baptismal services were held at Big Stick Lake. Reverend J. Schlipf, the first pastor, served from March through December 1913. The first deacon was Martin Boettcher and the first treasurer was Samuel Boettcher. The first Sunday School was conducted by Christian Hauf and Jacob Adam and the first Christmas program was held in 1913.

Early pastors who served were: D.D. Wegener 1914 to 1915; D. Ehman 1917; Kroker 1920 to 1922; Itterman 1924 to 1926; Henry Schatz 1926 to 1934; G. Beutler 1935; G. Itterman (his second term) 1936 to 1941; Gottfried Beutler 1941 to 1945.

The church built in 1915 was located two miles north of the cemetery, during the Saskatchewan/Alberta annual convention in the church, the building was dedicated June 28, 1916, debt free. A two storey parsonage was built with volunteer labor next to the church in 1917.

As early as 1910, another congregation named Annenthal was started with more than thirty members. It

was located about fifteen miles west of Rosenfeld. The two congregations shared one pastor.

Several members of the Rosenfeld Church served in the ministry: Carl Geiser, William Jaster, Azzaph Jaster, Robert Jaster and Arthur Zeller, as well Alfred Adam served as a missionary to India, Harold Adam served as an Evangelical United Brethren minister, Esther Adam became wife of Evangelist Ralph Sutera and Sharon Unrath Anhorn became a pastor's wife.

About 1944, with several members of the congregation taking up residence in Golden Prairie, Saskatchewan, it was decided to build a church in town and move the pastorage into town as well. The first pastor of this new church was Hugo Zepik. Dedication of the new building was October 20, 1945.

The Annenthal church disbanded in 1950, the remaining members joined the church in town.

Pastors serving both the Golden Prairie and Rosenfeld congregations included: Isador Faszer 1949 to March 28, 1952; Alphonz Lamprecht 1952 to 1955; Ernie Radke 1955 to 1958; Reuben Greuneich 1959 to 1963; David Unrau 1963 to 1967; Leroy Moser 1968; Tim Hughes 1969.

Starting in 1969 a pastor was shared with the congregation at Hilda, Alberta. Earl Wanamaker served in this capacity from 1969 to 1972; A.W. Reigel who traveled from Medicine Hat, Alberta, every Sunday served from 1972 to 1978. From 1978 to 1983 the services were conducted by the following pastors from Hillcrest Christian College at Medicine Hat, Alberta, Emil Riegel, Jeff Carter, Mark Horsch, John Elhard and Dale Schlenker. Resident pastor Harry Friess served from 1983 to 1986. Reverend Ray Ulrickson traveled from Medicine Hat, Alberta, every Sunday in 1986 and 1987. Tim Dekker arrived as resident pastor in March 1987 and was still serving in 1990.

The Rosenfeld congregation was disbanded in May 1955 after forty four years of ministry. The church building was moved to Glidden, Saskatchewan, and used until that congregation disbanded.

The cemetery looked very neat as at April 24, 1997, the grass is trimmed short, an excellent fence with painted posts surrounds the plot, all grave locations are marked with a stone or small metal cross.

The mission was organized about 1949, services prior to that time were held in private homes and were conducted by the priest from Richmond, Saskatchewan. Mass was celebrated in the town hall.

The former Meiers General Store building was converted to a church with dedication services conducted April 1952. The old Catholic church from Richmond was moved into Golden Prairie in 1958.

Priests who served this parish include Father Dugas, Father Boudreau and Father R.I. Lemieux.
