### **Hilda, Alberta.**

### **Walker Family Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta.**

The original Congregational Church was located at this site, eight miles west and two miles south of Hilda, Alberta, legal land description SE-28-17-02-W4. We understand that three burials took place here. The virgin prairie remains untouched by the plowshare; the graves can still be seen as at May 25, 1998.

### **Andrew Beierbach homestead, Hilda, Alberta.**

The land location is east one half 26-18-03- W 4 twelve miles west and five miles north of Hilda, Alberta. Congregational church records indicate a grave two feet south and three feet west of property line in northeast corner of northeast quarter.

Interred here are two children of Andrew Beierbach.

### **Stockburger Family Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta.**

This tiny family plot is located on the Stockburger homestead at SE 36-18-01- W 4 along the north line about 300 yards west of range road 20 and one and one half miles north of township road 184. As at October 10, 1996, we believe that at least seven burials occurred here including one Durr child.

A visit with Art Schlaht at Medicine Hat, Alberta, July 05, 1997, confirmed that two infants of Fred Sr. and Amalia Miller are interred here; this was later verified by Bertha nee Miller Purdy.

### **Fieger Family Plot, Hilda, Alberta.**

This small cemetery is eight miles west and two miles south of Hilda, Alberta, at the junction of range road 23 and township road 174. Legal land description is SE 28-17-02-W4. Plot is fenced but grass is uncut, as at August 12, 1995. Two unmarked graves inside the fence are probably Fieger family members.

A visit to the Provincial Archives at Edmonton Alberta, October 14, 1997, verified that there are at least two children interred here and possibly a third family member.

Fieger Katie died November 12, 1918, daughter of Joseph Fieger.  
Fieger Luckonia died November 14, 1918, daughter of Sebastian Fieger.

We assume that Ludwig Fieger who died February 03, 1924, of Anselm Fieger is interred here as well.

### **Original site of Zion Lutheran Church, Hilda, Alberta.**

The church was organized in 1912 under the direction of Missionary Bernard Bierwagen, the building was actually constructed in 1914. The first board of \_\_\_\_\_ ished in 1912 included: Anton Dewald John Lutz Gottlieb Bredo and Fred Roeder.

The church played an important part in the lives of its' members, regular services as well as weddings and funerals along with special services were conducted there. The first pastor in 1914 was Reverend Wilhelm Wiltenburg, he was followed by Reverend's Griesse, Walter Beltz, Lohman, Seitenstick, Maier, Martin Rische 1921 to 1923, John Meichsner 1923 to 1926, William Busse 1927 to 1929, Gerhardt Gehrs 1929 to 1934, Roland Langbecker 1934 to 1936, Klewer 1937, Rudolph Ohlinger, R. Kaun, Ernest Nayan 1938 to 1942, Phillip Becker 1942 to 1945, Walter Brockopp 1946 to 1947, Fred Schole 1948 to 1950, Edgar Priess 1950 to 1952, Louis Theiss 1953 to 1955, Frank Miller 1955 to 1958, G.E. Knoernschild 1958 to 1965, D. Igge 1965 to 1967, Albert Maschmayer and Vicars Fardin and Scharlach 1967 to 1969.

In 1961, the congregation renovated the former Maple Tree School located only one half mile from the church therefore the old church closed its doors in November 1963 It had celebrated its' 50th. anniversary November 17, 1963 with a special service. Reverend John Meichner was the guest speaker. The new church was dedicated that same afternoon with Reverend Thomas L. Ristine as guest speaker.

The new church was open for only six years, due to the decline in congregation caused by farm mechanization and the reduction of the number of families living in the rural area. The remaining members transferred their membership to Bethlehem Lutheran Church in 1969. The abandoned building was moved to Oyen, Alberta, and rededicated there in 1972.

The original cemetery in use from 1912 to 1935, is located nine miles west of Hilda, Alberta, at the junction of township road 180 and range road 24. Legal land description is NE 32-17-02-W4, the Emil Krause homestead. The one acre plot is well fenced, a cairn has been erected but grass needs attention, as at August 12,

1995.

### **Seventh Day Adventist Church, Hilda, Alberta.**

Fifteen members under the leadership of Pastor C.K. Reiswig organized this church in 1919. That summer, they purchased a vacant home and used it for a meeting place until purchasing an acre of property two miles north of Hilda, Alberta. A new church was built under the direction of Pastor Ben Reiley.

By this time the congregation had grown to about forty members. The 1940's witnessed a major movement of families away from the farms causing the membership to drop to just two families. This small group joined the church at Medicine Hat, Alberta, and the building stood vacant for almost fifty years.

The church building was moved to the Medicine Hat, Alberta, Exhibition grounds in August 1996, and after extensive restoration work is now part of a heritage village along with an old school and other buildings.

The cemetery is one mile west and two miles north of Hilda, Alberta, at the junction of township road 182 and range road 13. Legal land description is the SW 15 -18-01- W 4 the John Walter homestead. A new chain link fence surrounds this burial site. Many of the graves have caved in and there are signs of a badger doing his destructive work as at August 14, 1995.

We attempted to locate the burial records for this cemetery with the help of the Seventh Day Adventist Church at Medicine Hat, Alberta. A conversation with Mr. Edgar Boschee April 10, 1997, led us to believe that the records have been lost, the Church Conference was contacted, they do not have the records.

### **Baptist Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta.**

The Hilda Baptist Church has its beginnings in 1910. The first meeting was held in the home of George Heitzmann with twenty three charter members attending. Reverend F.A. Mueller was the first pastor.

Services were held in the Heitzmann home until the congregation out grew this cozy little house. The decision to build a church was made April 26, 1911. Mr. Heitzmann donated three acres of land for the church and graveyard. Dedication services were held July 15, 1911. The church was renamed from Hilda to Germantown and became a member of the North American Baptist Conference.

The membership grew steadily, after five years there were 151 members, resulting in construction of a new building in 1918 under the leadership of Reverend E.P. Wahl.

The building was moved into the hamlet of Hilda, Alberta, in 1928 and rededicated August 12, 1928. Another name change took place, reverting back to the Hilda Baptist Church. The parsonage was torn down and rebuilt in Hilda. In 1958 a new parsonage was built just north of the church. The old church was sold and moved to a local farm and a new church was built in the 1970's. In the first sixty three years to 1974, twenty three pastors served the Hilda Baptist Church. They not only served the Hilda church but served Fredensfelt and Neuberg before the 1920's, as well as Gnadenfeld and Burstall in the 1940's. A number of the members have gone on to become pastors, they include: Henry Schatz, Emil Becker, Adolph Semrau, Emil Frank, Harold Weiss, Rubin Herrmann, Robert Hoffmann, Walter Hoffman and Isadore Faszer. The church remains active and holds combined services with the Evangelical group. This cemetery is located one mile west and two miles south of Hilda, Alberta, at the junction of township road 174 and range road 12. The legal land description is NE 22-17-01-W4 the T.S. Montgomerie homestead. There is a good fence at this site, however the grass needs cutting. The congregation has erected a cairn listing those interred here and has marked all graves with a metal cross. There are a couple of discrepancies noted in names recorded on the cairn versus other records, also the cairn shows Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Lang as being interred here, they are interred in Hillside Cemetery at Medicine Hat, Alberta.

### **Congregational Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta.**

Starting in 1910, the early pioneers gathered at the home of George Miller or Dan Miller for their weekly church services. This congregation built their first church in 1912.

The congregation consisted of the following families: George Miller, Dan Miller, Gotthielf Bauch, Gottfred Tarnasky, Ben Wildermut, John Haas, Jacob Eberhardt, John and Phillip Gebhardt, Christian and Ferdinand Buchholz, Christian and Karl Zeiffle, Jack Scheifele, Christian Durr, John Bauman, William Kanewischer George Pichtigen, Adolf Schlenker and Karl Henke.

The first pastor Reverend E. Bernstein performed the first wedding when Reinhold Gomke and Charlotte Gebhardt were united in holy matrimony.

Pastors serving this church included Heinrich Freise, G.J. Rieker, John A. Hochstatter, F.W. Gross and W.E. Sieber.

The original church was used until 1932 when a larger building was moved from Round Lake to the John Haas property about one mile south and one mile east of the old site. The church was closed in 1935.

This cemetery is located six miles west and one mile south of Hilda, Alberta, or one mile south of the junction of township road 180 and range road 21. Legal land description is SW 36-17-02-W4 the John Gebhardt homestead. The fence is in good condition and the grass needs to be cut. A number of bushes have grown high enough to hide a few grave markers. There is an indication of some vandalism as at June 12, 1994.

The original records for this location were located at Medicine Hat, Alberta, early in 1999, Ron Bender from Hilda, Alberta, was able to get a copy of the register after making several calls to the person who holds the books. He was kind enough to forward a copy to me April 22, 1999.

## **Bethlehem Lutheran Church Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta**

The history for this church was gathered from various sources, some of the original documents were destroyed by fire.

The Bethlehem Lutheran congregation was beginning to form in 1910. The congregation of the Evangelical Bethlehem Lutheran Gemeinde was organized in 1911 by Reverend J. Obenhammer who was living and serving a congregation at Irvine, Alberta.

During 1911 and 1912, services were conducted in a rural school. Construction of the first church started in spring 1913 and was dedicated that fall. A parsonage was built in 1914. This home was sold and moved into Hilda, Alberta, just east of the hotel. The church building was moved into Hilda, Alberta, in 1945 and continued to serve its' congregation until being razed in September 1962. Pastor G. Weiss was the last resident pastor of this congregation. Ground breaking services were held September 16, 1962, the cornerstone laid October 28, 1962, and volunteers under the direction of Jack Ehman had the building ready for use by Christmas that year. Dedication services were Sunday, July 14, 1963.

The Bethlehem Lutheran Church is part of the Schuler Parish. A new Parish parsonage was built at Schuler, Alberta, in 1964. As Bethlehem went into the seventies, the members found it more and more difficult to keep the congregation financially operative. Many members had transferred to Medicine Hat, Alberta, as a result Pastor S. Kirschenman was the last resident pastor of the parish. The congregation was then served from Leader, Saskatchewan, and Medicine Hat, Alberta. In November, 1975, Pastor Emil Krause was called to look after the parish.

A motion September 09, 1962, allowed for a new twenty two foot wide by fifty foot long church to be built. The cemetery is located on the SW 07-18-01-W4, the Samuel Koch homestead five miles west and one and one half miles north of Hilda, Alberta, or one half mile south of the junction of township road 182 and range road 20. The general condition of this plot is good, surrounded by a single cable fence, the grass is kept trimmed and an effort is being made to fill in the cave ins. The Lutheran church congregations have erected a cairn which lists all those interred here. As at August 12, 1995.

## **Salem Evangelical Cemetery, Hilda, Alberta.**

In 1916 with assistance from Pastor Borne plans were made by a group of local residents to build a church. Fred Anhorn, Adam Flaig, Gust Fandrich, Christ Walker, Fred Vossler and Mrs. Schneider each took a wagon load of grain to Estuary, Saskatchewan, and returned with a load of lumber.

The building was constructed under the capable direction of Reverend F .E. Martin who dedicated the building in 1917.

The first marriage performed in the new building was between Gust Fandrich and the same Mrs. Schneider who helped haul lumber in 1916.

The congregation decided to move the church into Hilda, Alberta, in the 1930's. Mr. Jack Ginther from Mendham, Saskatchewan, moved the structure by using a combination of horses and tractors.

Pastors who served here included: F.E. Martin, Samuel Senft, Henry Senft, Henry Riegel, E. Streitz, E.W. Riegel, Dave Unrau, E.M. Brust, Henry Leischoer, L.E. Sackman, E. Kowalsky, Herald Adams, D. Schindell, Vern Schorr, George Brandt, A.W. Riegel and Dave Pahl. The church building no longer exists as at September 03, 1996.

The cemetery is located two miles north of Hilda, Alberta, at the junction of township road 182 and range road 11. The legal land description is NW 12-18-01- W 4 on the Henry Kundert homestead. The one acre plot is surrounded by a good fence, a good percentage of the graves have markers, the plot seems to have received attention recently. As found June 20, 1994.
