Good Hope Lutheran Cemetery, Schuler, Alberta.

The cemetery is located on the north side of the road six miles east and six miles south of Schuler, Alberta. Legal land description is SE 17-15-29-W3. There is a new chain link fence encompassing the one acre plot. The trees and shrubs have been cleared from the entire area. Many of the small fences around individual graves need attention as does the long grass. As at August 31, 1996. The first burial was November 26, 1913, the last burial was November 07, 1952.

United Church Cemetery, Schuler, Alberta

The church at this location was started as a German Congregational Church, in 1924, the Methodist, Presbyterian and Congregational churches joined to form the United Church. This location became known as the Surprise United Church.

The last pastor to serve was Reverend Paul Hediger who left in 1947. The church was closed in 1956 and the building was moved to Scandia, Alberta.

The cemetery lies five miles east of Schuler, Alberta, on the south side of township road 162, about one and

one half miles across the border into Saskatchewan. Legal land description is NW 08-16-29-W3. The shrunken property is enclosed with a good barbed wire fence, many of the wooden fences surrounding the individual graves are broken down and several graves are caved in. The grass is knee deep as at August 31, 1996. Some of the following information has been taken from the Schuler, Alberta, history book.

Total number of burials was estimated at 25 in five rows, we found records for twenty eight burials, some of the children could be interred in same grave. There is a single grave in the southwest corner. There are six fenced graves near the east end.

Daffy nee Heather Carolina born August 08, 1865, died April 01, 1931, at Medicine Hat, Alberta, wife of Jacob Daffy.
